6 reporter or recording device will record any testimony taken on the tour for transcription.
7 Public health and safety protocols specific for the tour will be included on the itinerary.

20 Each county and municipal government and state agency interested in the Project
21 and desiring to be a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten days before the date set
22 for hearing, file with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200
23 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007 a notice of intent to be a party.

24 Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to
25 promote conservation of natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health or
26 other biological values, to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests, to
27 represent commercial and industrial groups, or to promote the orderly development of the

1 area in which the Project are to be located and desiring to become a party to the
2 proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before June 7, 2023, file with the Director of
3 Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix,
4 Arizona 85007 a notice of intent to be a party.

5 The Committee or its Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other
6 persons parties to the proceeding. Any person may make a limited appearance at a hearing
7 by filing a statement in writing with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation
8 Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, not less than five
9 days before the date set for hearing. A person making a limited appearance shall not be a
10 party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine witnesses.

11 This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes §§ 40-360 to 40-360.13 and
12 Arizona Administrative Code R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. No substantive communication
13 not in the public record may be made to any member of the Committee. The written
14 decision of the Committee will be submitted to the Arizona Corporation Commission
15 pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to
16 the proceedings on these matters before the Arizona Corporation Commission must be a
17 party to the proceedings before the Committee.
